Building a Lifeline for Families In Need

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The mission of Claris Health is to equip and care for individuals and their families before, during, and after pregnancy and sexual-health choices. For **nearly 50 years**, Claris has walked alongside individuals and families in their most vulnerable moments, offering **medical**, **mental health**, **and support services** that foster hope and stability.

We serve **all of Los Angeles** through two clinics in **West and South LA and a mobile clinic**. In the past decade , **15,000 families** have found life-changing support—

and we are just getting started.



Nearly half of pregnancies in South Los Angeles are unintended. Many of these parents face trauma, housing insecurity, and domestic violence where the healthcare system is failing them. Navigating a fragmented healthcare and social services system without transportation or childcare and with a high mistrust of providers leaves families without options for care.

The Clarity Together Campus

represents a critical shift in care reducing barriers and coordinating care.

A Call for Urgent Action

South Los Angeles families face systemic barriers and preventable health disparities:

- **Teen birth rates** in South LA are the highest in Los Angeles County
- African American infant mortality are three times the rate of caucasian infants
- **One in three** residents (33.6%) lives below the Federal Poverty Line.
- **One in three** adults struggle to access healthcare services.

<u>The community deserves a solution.</u> The **Clarity Together Campus** offers a community-centered model to meet these urgent needs.





A Groundbreaking Solution

The Clarity Together Campus brings together medical, mental health, financial, and educational resources in one traumainformed setting. This model reduces family separation risk and ensures timely, compassionate care in one location - when and where families need it most.

This pioneering model has the potential for *national replication*, particularly in:

- States with restrictive abortion laws, where birth rates are rising among individuals who may lack resources for parenthood.
- States with high abortion rates, where families who choose parenting or adoption often lack necessary support.

A Hub for Healing and Opportunity

Located in Inglewood, CA the 28,000square-foot facility is designed for impact:

- Affordable offices for aligned service providers.
- A unified, trauma-informed care network.
- Care Coordinators navigating families through services efficiently.
- A **welcoming, community space**, with free drop-in childcare, a safe playground, coffee shop, and event space.

The Clarity Together Campus is an investment in generational change where families receive not just services, but a pathway to stability and hope.

A Transformative Approach to Care

The Clarity Together Campus will:

- Eliminate travel and access barriers.
- Ensure timely, coordinated referrals.
- Support trauma recovery in a safe space.
- Increase healthcare engagement by 50%.
- **Foster** community through events and educational workshops.



Funding Plan -Clear and Impactful

Total Philanthropic Goal: \$26.9M

- Property: \$5.3 million
- Design and construction \$20 million
- Campaign Costs \$600,000
- Three-year expanded operations \$1 million

This project will be **fully funded through philanthropy**– a **debt-free** launch for long-term sustainability.
